CURRENT NEWS/ WHATS HAPPENING THIS WEEK

FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today, Sunday, we celebrate the feast day of **Our Lady of Mount Carmel**. Hermits lived on Mount Carmel in Northern Israel in the 12th century. By the 13th century they became known as the “Brothers of Our Lady of Mount Carmel”. For centuries, the Carmelites have seen themselves as specially related to Mary. St John of the Cross credited Mary with saving him from drowning as a child, leading him to Carmel and helping him escape from prison.

Wednesday, 19th July, is the feast day of **St Mary MacKillop** who was born in Melbourne in 1842. She struggled for official approval for the order she founded, the Sisters of St Joseph of the Sacred Heart, known as the Josephite Sisters. The sisters offered social services that few government agencies in Australia could, including working among aborigines. She was canonised in 2010 and became Australia’s first saint.

Few women are more honoured in the Bible than **St Mary Magdalene**. She stood at Calvary, went to anoint the body of Jesus and was the first witness of the Resurrection. She is known as the “Apostle to the Apostles” and is the patron saint of penitents and of perfumers.
