## **THIRTY FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

Thursday, 9<sup>th</sup> November is the Feast of the **Dedication of the St John Lateran Basilica** – most Catholics think St Peter's is the Pope's main church, but they are wrong. St John's Lateran is the Pope's church, the Cathedral of the Diocese of Rome. One of Rome's most imposing churches, the Lateran's towering façade is crowned with 15 colossal statues of Christ, St John the Baptist, John the Evangelist and 12 Doctor's of the Church. Beneath its high altar rest the remains of the small wooden table on which tradition holds St Peter celebrated Mass. This church is the spiritual home of the people who are the Church.

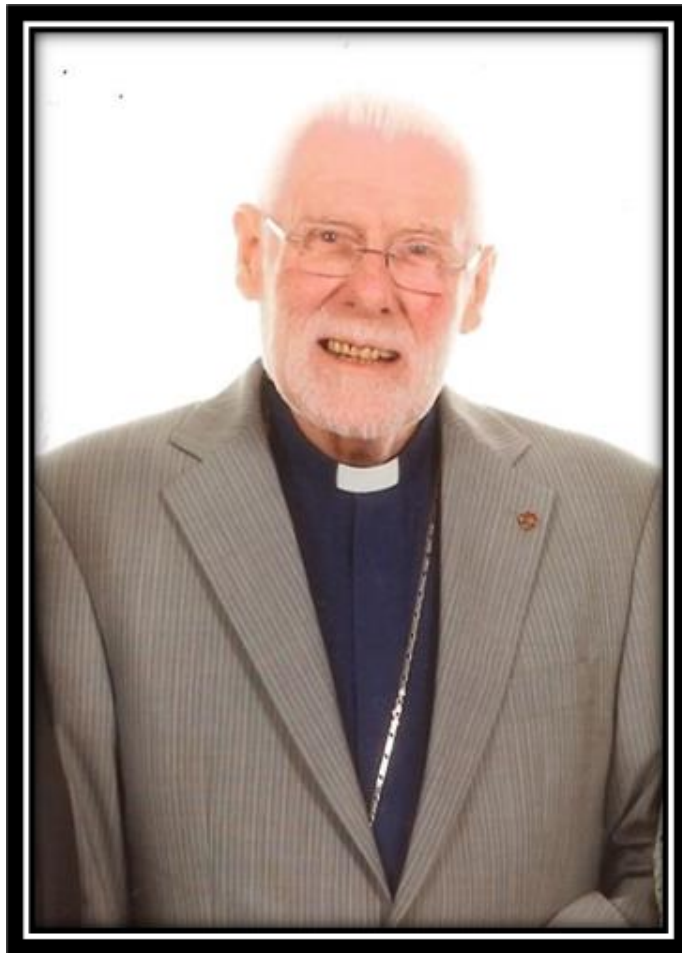
