### **CORPUS CHRISTI**

Today is the feast day of **Corpus Christi**. We celebrate the real Presence of the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus in the Eucharist.

Wednesday, 5<sup>th</sup> June is the feast day of **St Boniface** who was born in Devon in 672. He became an English Benedictine monk and later devoted his life to the conversion of Germanic tribes.

The Feast of the **Most Sacred Heart of Jesus** is celebrated on Friday, 7<sup>th</sup> June. The next day, Saturday, is the memorial of the **Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary**. It signifies the great purity and love of the heart of Mary for God.

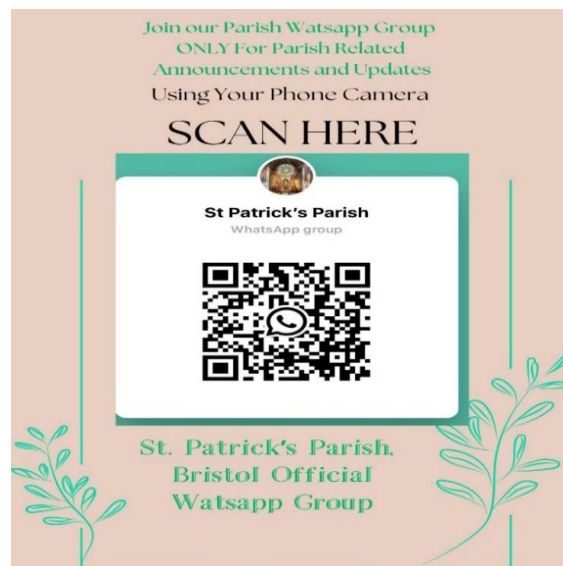
