#### **TENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

On Tuesday, 11<sup>th</sup> June, we celebrate the feast day of **St Barnabas**, Apostle. He was an early Christian disciple but not one of the twelve. Legend claims he died a martyr at Salamis, Cyprus, in AD61 and he is the patron saint of Cyprus.

The feast day of **St Anthony of Padua** is held on Thursday, 13<sup>th</sup> June. He was born in Lisbon in 1193 and was a Franciscan whose preaching took him from North Africa to Italy and France. he died in Padua in 1231.

**St Albert Chmielowski** was born near Krakow and was a talented artist who studied in Warsaw and Paris. He founded the Brothers of the Third Order of St Francis in Krakow working with the homeless. He died in 1916 and was canonised in 1989 by Pope John Paul II.




#### **GLASTONBURY COACH**
